- 1st working draft of the requirements document published 6 May 2020
- RIPE DB TF BoF took place 6th May 2020

Taskforce Usage Survey Results

- We carried out a usage survey to better understand the users needs
 - 206 responses, thank you!
- We had some unexpected usage results;
 - Use of the database for IPAM (IP Address Management)
 - RPSL
 - Geolocation

Taskforce Usage Survey Results

- Other interesting discussion points;
 - Data accuracy;
 - Accuracy is an ambiguous term and needs context
 - Personal information;
 - Do we need personal data in the RIPE Database?
 - IRT objects;
 - Are they being used and is the community aware of them?

Database Purpose

- Provide accurate registration information of Internet number resources
- Facilitating communication about usage of the resources
- Publishing routing policies by network operators (RIPE IRR)
- Provisioning of Reverse Domain Name System (rDNS)
- RPKI not part of the RIPE Database but compliments and references the RIPE Database

Other Uses

- Research into network operations and topology
- ENUM
- Geolocation
- IPAM
- Enabling transfer of IP resources
